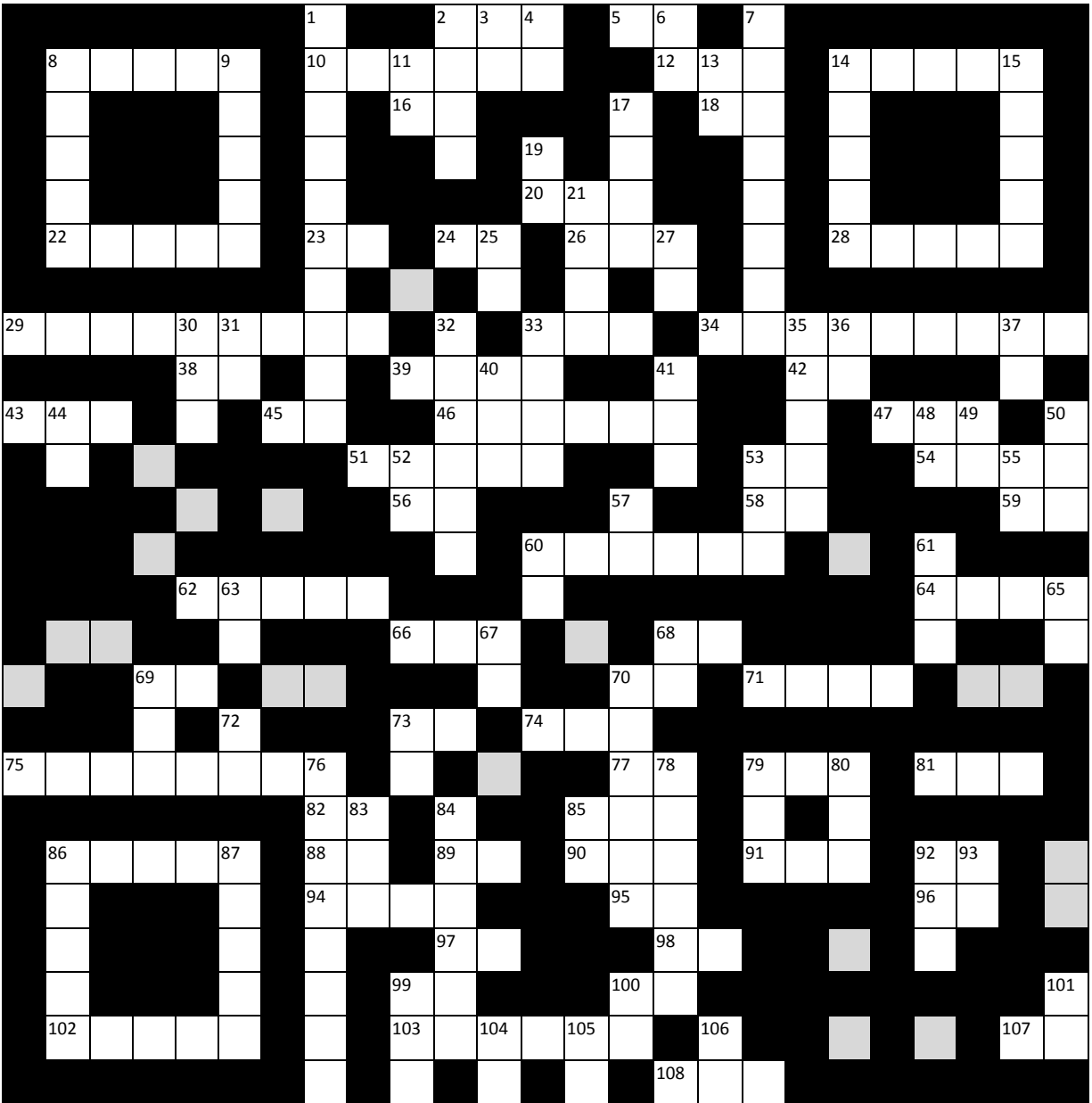


Crazy Crossword
